<b>W1. Masseo Bianco, Trebbiano, Umbria, Italy 11.5%</b> <i>Easy drinking style being fresh and fruity, great on its own or with pasta and white meats.</i>	£4.20	£5.60	£16.80
<b>W2. Kleindal, Chenin Blanc, Robertson, South Africa 13.0%</b> <i>Wax, lemon peel, apple and pear aroma. Attractive wine with earthy minerality and hints of stone fruit. Nicely textured and very drinkable.</i>	£4.40	£5.90	£17.60
<b>W3. Confidenza, Pinot Grigio, Umbria, Italy 12%</b> <i>Delivers a slightly citric nose with a hint of apple. The palate is rich and creamy with tropical fruits and a citrusy zing.</i>	£4.60	£6.10	£18.25
<b>W4. Cape Heights, Chardonnay, Western Cape, South Africa 13.5%</b> <i>Fresh, tangy varietal fruit with perfumed jasmine notes and white stone fruit flavours. Has breadth on the palate and a refreshing finish.</i>	£4.85	£6.50	£19.40
<b>W5. Gavi Valle Berta, San Silvestro, Cortese, Monferrat, Italy 11.5%</b> <i>Aromas of lime zest and grapefruit, hints of fresh fennel. Dry and with moderate acidity, it offers a clean and refreshing finish..</i>	£5.15	£6.80	£20.50
<b>W6. Baron Philippe de Rothschild, Viognier, Languedoc Roussillon, France 13%</b> <i>Nose showing typical Viognier stone fruits with slightly floral overtones. <b>W7. Neptune Point, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 12.5%</b> <i>This luscious wine combines intense white peaches, gooseberry &amp; nectarine aromas with a full fresh fruit flavours &amp; a long, lingering finish</i>	£5.50	£7.30	£21.90
<b>W8. Vouvray, Ackerman, Chenin Blanc 2014, Loire Valley, France 12.5%</b> <i>Slightly honeyed, floral nose followed by a luscious, medium dry palate with echoes of the honeyed nose but showing great fruit and wonderful acidity to counter the honeyed overtones. A top Vouvray not usually available by the glass!</i>	£5.70	£7.50	£22.75
<b>W9. Collavini, Ribolla Gialla 2014, Friuli, Italy 13.5%</b> <i>Straw yellow with pale green highlights. Floral essences of acacia blossom and lemon verbena. Citrusy palate perks up the elegant finish</i>			£24.50
<b>W10. Bodegas Eidosela Breixo, Albarino 2013, Galicia, Spain 13.0%</b> <i>Straw with green flashes, Pears &amp; apples on the nose and palate which is very long and possesses great acidity, Albarino is catching on!</i>			£25.50
<b>W11. St. Veran, Domaine Botti, Chardonnay, Burgundy, France 13.0%</b> <i>The wine is pale with green tinges and has mineral notes combined with creamy ripe fruit through to a crisp and clean finish. As the wine matures, it acquires an aroma of roasted almonds and honey.</i>			£29.00
<b>W12. Sancerre Serge Laloue Cul De Beaujeu, Sauvignon Blanc 2010, Loire, France 14.5%</b> <i>Intense bouquet with lovely complexity, citrus notes opening up to floral scents and a hint of rhubarb. Full flavoured and classically styled Sancerre with fresh minerality and spice sustained through to the long finish.</i>			£33.75
<b>W13. Domaine Rene Monnier Bourgogne, Chardonnay 2013, Burgundy, France 12.5%</b> <i>Shhh!!! A Meursault in all but name!!</i> . Elegant style of Chardonnay with a lovely lees weight and balanced oak flavours. Rich, opulent style with a touch of minerality on the finish.			£39.00
<b>W14. Chablis 1er Cru, Domaine Jean Goulley 'Montmains' Chardonnay 2011, Burgundy, France 12.5%</b> <i>The nose of this wine opens up nicely after a short breathing period to reveal floral and honeyed notes. Flavours of ripe stone fruits mix with great minerality followed by a long and powerful, creamy finish.</i>			£44.00
<b>W15. Beaune Albert Morot 1er Cru Les Aigrots 2008 Chardonnay, Burgundy, France 13.5%</b> <i>Classy, spicy, slightly peachy nose with honeysuckle overtones, the wine shows lovely buttery integration of fruit with oak coupled with flinty minerality, wonderful acidity and a long, lingering finish.</i>			£53.00
<b>W16. Chateau Neuf du Pape Domaine de la Solitude Cuvee Barberini 2007, France 13.5%</b> <i>85% Roussanne, 15% Clairette, this wine is seriously endowed, complex, and creamy textured, the Barberini exhibits plenty of rose petal, honeysuckle, and marmalade notes. Shows the forward, ripe profile of the vintage, with delicious plum, violet, black liquorice and fig notes backed by velvety texture and lots of fruitcake and spice on the finish. Very lush and flattering.</i>			£83.00

<b>R10. Domaine des Cigalounes 2012, Lirac, Rhone Valley, France 14.50%</b>	<i>Grenache led Rhone Blend. Attractive deep red. Aromatic and smooth with notes of fruit and spices. A soft and full wine with an extremely silky-textured finish.</i>			<b>£25.75</b>
<b>R11. Bodegas Arca de Noe Don Paulino Reserva 2006 Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain 14.0%</b>	<i>Beautiful nose with hints of balsamic, bilberries, anis and fig. Creamy palate with hints of spice, vanilla and oak. Seriously smooth with beautiful balanced tannins and a long finish. The cat is not out of the bag on this wine yet, a real discovery!</i>			<b>£27.75</b>
<b>R12. Perez Cruz Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2013, Maipo Valley, Chile</b>	<i>Red currant blackberries and a touch of tarragon and black pepper nose, concentrated palate, lovely tannins and fresh acidity on the finish</i>			<b>£30.50</b>
<b>R13. Chronic Cellars Purple Paradise 2013, Zinfandel, Paso Robles, California, 14.5%</b>	<i>Zinfandel is California's premier red varietal, Purple Paradise has a rich dark colour intense smoky, vanilla, cherry, chocolate and spice flavours. The tannins are soft and the acidity balanced in this delicious wine. This is a very serious wine. Think Steak!!</i>			<b>£35.00</b>
<b>R14. Domaine René Monnier Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2014, Burgundy, France 12.50%</b>	<i>From a top Premier Cru Beaune producer, this is <b>pretty much a 1'ier Cru Beaune in all but name</b>. Typical Pinot Noir on the nose with w. raspberry, ripe cherry and savoury notes. It is followed with pure vibrant redberry fruit supported with firm tannins. The finish is dry and consistent. Real quality here.</i>			<b>£39.00</b>
<b>R15. Altimus by Michel Torino, 2011, Malbec 61% Cab Sav 25% Cab Franc, Cafayate, Argentina 15%</b>	<i>From some of the highest vineyards in the world, deep brooding crimson wine shows a nose of chocolate, toasty oak, red fruit jam and a hint of smoke. On the palate, concentrated red fruits and well balanced tannins combine beautifully. Top organic Malbec led taste bomb!!!</i>			<b>£41.50</b>
<b>R16. Chateau Cissac 2011, Cab Sav 70%, Merlot 25%, 5% Petit Verdot, Medoc, France, 13.50%</b>	<i>Textbook Médoc with plenty of juicy, chunky blackcurrant fruit, firm tannins and fine length. Cissac's new style has good balance, and is no longer overwhelmed by the tannins of the older veintages.</i>			<b>£45.50</b>
<b>R17. Château Musar 2008, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault, Carignan, &amp; More, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 13.0%</b>	<i>On the nose it is very true to Musar form, showing deliciously sweet fruit nuanced with cloves and a dried and spicy character. Plenty of apples too. On the palate, still youthful and richly imbued with structure, lots of dried fruit to the fore. Will benefit greatly from being decanted. Musar is a chameleon and when drunk over the course of a meal changes in character.</i>			<b>£49.00</b>
